During tryouts your dancer will be evaluated on their skills, as well as how they execute those skills. Tryouts are CLOSED to parents. Teachers will evaluate skills and place them on competition teams. The dancer's placement on a team is at the teacher's discretion.

The teams start their practices on September 4th. Each class is held once a week. They are required to take a jazz technique class and a ballet class in addition to their competitive classes. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Try out fee is \$50 and is due at tryouts.

All dance tuition will be due on the 1st of the month. If not paid by the 10th, there will be a \$15 late fee added to your account.

Extra practices will have a fee of \$10 per practice.

COSTUMES

Parents will be responsible for purchasing their dancers' costumes. This includes, but is not limited to, tights, earrings, hair piece, dance shoes, competition fees, recital fees, recital ticketing, competitions shirts, music fees, practice uniform, coaches fees etc. Costumes typically run \$85 per costume. All costume fees must be paid before your costume will be ordered.

TRAVEL FEES

Our studio does travel for competition. We try to stay between San Antonio and Austin. All travel costs are the responsibility of the dancers' families. Most dance competitions are free to get into but ones like Six Flags, Spurs and SeaWorld will need a ticket to enter. These fees are not included in the monthly tuition.

We will have fundraising opportunities for your dancer to participate in Fundraising opportunities will be posted on your band app. Keep an eye out for it. It is not mandatory for you to participate.
